

Drainage Board

September 7, 2010 – 11:30 am

Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Rininger, Gogel, Surveyor Herron and Attorney Robinson were present.

Minutes

11/03/2010 minutes and 11/18/2010 minutes; Rininger made a motion to approve. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

Pigeon Creek

Herron met with Warrick County Surveyor Baxter and contractors to discuss the specs for the Warrick County portion of the Pigeon Creek project. Bid opening will be on September 13 at 2:00 pm at a Warrick County Drainage Board meeting.

Garrett Creek

Herron reported he is still waiting on the Corp of Engineer permits for Garrett Creek.

Crooked Creek – Center Section

Herron state he is working on the bid specs for the center section of the Crooked Creek project.

Country Ridge Estates – Myers' Property

Herron reported he took elevation shots at Country Ridge Estates Subdivision and the Myers' property and he has a proposal to help alleviate the flooding problems both are experiencing. Discussion was had on if it was legal to work on the private property. Robinson said the drain is a lateral of Huffman Drain and as long as the county has an easement from the land owner, the county can work on the drain. Herron reported the Country Ridge Estates Home Owners Association has agreed to pay \$3,000 toward the project. Robinson said this is allowable since they are helping to correct a problem that was created by the subdivision.

One part of the proposed solution is to install a culvert under the Myers' driveway. Logsdon asked if the county would be allowed to repair the paved driveway after the culvert is in place. Robinson stated the repair can be made because it is done to settle a dispute between Country Ridge Estates, the Myers' and the county.

Logsdon complimented all those who worked together to settle the flooding issue. He directed Herron to check with the utilities before work begins. A special drainage board meeting will be held on September 21 at 2:15 pm, prior to the commissioners' meeting.
