July 7, 2009 – 11:30 am

Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Rininger, Gogel, Surveyor Herron and Attorney Robinson were present.

Minutes

06/02/2009 minutes; Rininger made a motion to approve the minutes. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

Bid Opening- Sam Finch Drain

Surveyor Herron stated that the Surveyor's Estimate on the Sam Finch Drain is \$6,500 to \$7,000.

Attorney Robinson opened and read the bids as follows:

Sam's Backhoe Service	\$7,295.00
K & K Dirtworks, Inc.	\$5,950.00
Highpoint, Inc.	\$16,500.00

Herron recommended accepting K & K as low bidder. Rininger made a motion to accept the K & K Dirtworks bid of \$5,950. Gogel seconded. All in favor. Robin Knepper of K & K said the work will be completed prior to the Grandview Fall Festival.

Isaac Wright Lateral Drain

Surveyor Herron discussed the flooding near the Isaac Wright Lateral Drain. He has visited the site and had pictures of the problems. He said there are not any funds available for the Isaac Wright Drain. Logsdon told Herron to estimate what needs to be done to help alleviate the problem, and then he and Herron can present the recommendation to the Drainage Advisory Committee. Logsdon also said they need to meet with the residents in the area and explain exactly what can and cannot be done.

Huffman Drain

Herron reported that Highpoint is working on Huffman Drain and he is overseeing the progress.

CR 200 N by Gray Property

Herron stated that he has marked approximately 1,300 feet of clearing that needs to be done on Huffman Drain off CR 200 N. near the Gray property. He estimates that the work will cost about \$3,500 to \$4,000. The bid opening will be at the August meeting.

Pigeon Creek

Herron reported that he is still talking with Warrick County and working on identifying the log jams on Pigeon Creek.

FEMA Funds

Logsdon reminded Herron that the when the FEMA funds are used to clean drains a clear paper trail needs to be kept.

Drainage 101

Logsdon discussed the Drainage 101 training class and encouraged Herron and Deputy Jones to attend.

Rininger made a motion to adjourn. Gogel seconded. All in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 12:01 pm.
