Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Rininger, Gogel, and Surveyor Herron were present. Attorney Robinson was not present.

Minutes

Surveyor's Report

Isaac Wright Drain (Vinton Woods) – Herron reported that Sam's Backhoe has begun work on the Isaac Wright Drain and he is doing a good job.

Sam Finch Drain – Herron stated work is still being done on the Sam Finch Drain in Grandview.

FEMA Reimbursement – Herron stated that the county was only given an extension through January of 2010 to complete the FEMA projects. He does not feel the work can be completed in the time allowed due to wet weather and crops in the fields. But he is working on some specs to be let out at the November meeting. Logsdon stated that the board may need to plan on having multiple meetings in the months to come to get the projects bid. Logsdon also reminded Herron of the importance of having the claims for the FEMA projects labeled so the Auditor's office can track the usage of the funds.

Pigeon Creek & Crooked Creek – Herron stated he is still waiting on the water to go down so specs can be drawn up.

Health Department – Sanitation

Rita Stallings, Sanitation Administrator in the Health Department, requested permission to extend a perimeter drain to Robert Hatfield Drain and locate a new septic system within a 75 foot right-of-way. Rodney Roby has upgraded his home and needs to improve his septic system. Rininger made a motion to approve both requests made through permit #09027 for Rodney Roby located at 8683 W. CR 150N, Richland, Indiana. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

Rininger made a motion to adjourn. Gogel seconded. All in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 11:54 am.
