Crooked Creek

Herron said he will begin the process of putting Crooked Creek out for bid using FEMA funds.

Pigeon Creek at Lincoln Trail

Herron said he received a call about log jams found on Pigeon Creek at Lincoln Trail Road, but he thinks they may be completely inside Warrick County.

Sandage Farms

Logsdon asked Herron if highway culverts need to be replaced in the drains being cleared by Sandage Farms. Herron said two culverts are being lowered by the highway department.
