

Drainage Board

March 5, 2007 – 11:51 am

Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Leiberling, and Rininger, Surveyor Sublett and Attorney Robinson were present.

Minutes

February 15, 2007 minutes. Rininger made the motion to approve. Leiberling seconded. All in favor.

Surveyor Report

Huffman Drain Bid Opening – Sublett stated two bids have come in on the Huffman Drain project. Robinson opened the bids.

K & K Dirt Works, Inc. - \$2,100

Herron Excavating - \$2,600

Leiberling made a motion to accept the bids and award the bid to K & K. Rininger seconded. All in favor.

Thermwood – Sublett spoke with Bob Reinke and James Strobel, land owners adjacent to Thermwood. They agreed that even if the ditch behind their property was widened it would not stop the flooding. He and Painter are looking into making the pipe under CR 1800 N larger and clean out the ditch on the other side and they feel that will alleviate the problem. It is a tributary to Little Pigeon Creek. Logsdon asked if there was money for maintenance for Little Pigeon. Sublett said yes. Logsdon asked if a dry dam can be put in on the west side of the industrial complex. Sublett has been trying to talk to the companies about that. Sublett stated that Dale needs to have a drainage plan. Logsdon stated that about a year and a half ago the commissioners met with the heads of the companies in the complex and recommended both a dry dam on the west side and a holding area before it crossed the county road so flow could be restricted.

Legal Report

Baker Creek Debt Repayment - Robinson reported that he has researched the Baker Creek debt repayment. It was mentioned in the August 7, 2000 minutes. He checked the SBA reports and there is no mention of a requirement for the repayment; it only shows the deficit. Logsdon would like to have a formal meeting with the SBA and ask to wipe the debt clean.

Other Business

Painter explained Leonard James and Byron Stallings are having problems with the drain along CR 750. It is a road ditch and it is not draining.

Logsdon asked Sublett to check out the drain along CR 650, which drains into Baker Creek, where the Epperson Family lives, starting around Jimmy Meece's and coming north and give the board a plan for eliminating that drainage problem. He would like an estimate for the whole project and an estimate of the project done in stages by the April 2nd meeting.

Leiberling made a motion to adjourn. Rininger seconded. All in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 12:10.
