Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Rininger, Gogel, Surveyor Herron, and Attorney Robinson were present.

Minutes

07/06/2010 minutes; Rininger made a motion to approve. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

New State Law – Logjams

Attorney Robinson reported the state has amended IC14-28-1-22 to loosen the permit requirements to remove a logjam or debris accumulated in a floodway. Permits are still required from IDEM and the Corp of Engineers if applicable.

Garrett Creek

Surveyor Herron stated he is still waiting on permits for Garrett Creek.

Little Pigeon Lateral

Herron requested permission to pursue the straightening and clearing of the Little Pigeon Creek Lateral starting at CR 1800N to the railroad trestle. Rininger made a motion for Herron to obtain quotes on straightening and clearing the Little Pigeon Creek lateral. Gogel seconded. All in favor. Logsdon instructed Herron to also contact Norfolk Southern.

The quote opening will be at a special meeting following the commissioners meeting on Wednesday, August 18 at 11:30 am.

Jackson Creek

Discussion was had on trees down in Jackson Creek off Patronville Road. Painter said he will see if the trees are close enough to the county road for the highway department to remove.

Mid America Terminals

Herron stated he received a letter from the state asking how the proposed Mid America Terminal project will impact the county. Logsdon asked Herron to reply saying the county supports the project and it will have no negative impact.

CR 275 Culvert

Jimmy Wink requested permission to replace a culvert along CR 275, south of SR 66. Logsdon asked him to work with Surveyor Herron, Superintendent Painter, and Engineer Lloyd to measure the volume of water and the impact on Subway and Dawson's Machine Shop. Rininger made a motion to allow the replacement of the culvert if it is agreed that the new culvert will solve the flooding problems and not impact the businesses along SR 161. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

Rininger made a motion to adjourn. Gogel seconded. All in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 12:13 am.
